The Role

The Nurse Practitioner is a core primary care and lifestyle medicine health care provider. The qualified individual will work both independently as well as alongside physicians, MACNs (Medical Assistant Coach Navigators), dietitians and other members of the LMS health care team. She/he will see patients one on one, and will also participate in morning huddles, group visits, and connectivity councils. This full time position will focus on two of our three offices – Corona and Riverside.

Essential responsibilities

- Functions independently to perform age-appropriate history and physical for complex acute, critical, and chronically ill patients
- Orders and interprets diagnostic and therapeutic tests relative to patient's age-specific needs
- Prescribes appropriate treatment modalities, based on LMS's lifestyle medicine philosophy
- Implements interventions to support the patient to regain or maintain physiologic stability
- Monitors the effectiveness of interventions
- Collaborates with multidisciplinary team members by making appropriate referrals.
- Facilitates staff, patient and family decision making by providing educational tools.

Minimum qualifications

- Graduate of an accredited school of nursing/accredited Nurse Practitioner Program
- Certified or commitment to be certified in Lifestyle Medicine (see ABLM.co)
- Licensed (or licensable) in the state of California
- Strong computer skills, including Word, Excel, and PowerPoint
- Bi-lingual (English/Spanish) preferred
