Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.Sc. Nursing)

- The four year academic program has been running since 1995.
- The prerequisite for eligibility to B.Sc. Nursing is 10+2 Science.
- 20 students were admitted each in year but 30 students are enrolled this year.

Bachelor of Nursing Science (BNS)

- The new 3 and half year nursing academic program.
- The prerequisite for eligibility to B.Sc. Nursing is Certificate in Nursing.

Strength of our programme

- Students will be selected without discrimination (Religious, cast and economical status) but special concern will be given to those who are marginalized, oppressed or under privileged in the country.
- Leader and faculty and staffs of this college are well qualified and experience and committed.
