





# IINTERNATIONAL FUNDRAISER STARTED Purchase of an International Council of Nurses Traveling Library of Nursing Books

Gamma Alpha Chapter has started raising funds to purchase one traveling library for a country in need of up-to-date nursing texts for nurses to use as a resource in providing care. The International Council of Nurses, in partnership with major nursing text-book publishers has created the nursing mobile library, an innovative resource to bring current health information to nurses working in remote areas of developing countries. The library contains 90 nursing and health publications including books, manuals and fact sheets. The books are housed in a durable, movable trunk protecting the materials from dust, water, insects and hard knocks. This means that the library can be easily transported to remote areas over difficult terrain. Each traveling library cost \$3,000, which includes the materials, trunk, and shipping to the country.

So far, the chapter has raised \$1220. We 're 1/3 of the way there! If you would like to contribute to this project, make a check payable to "Gamma Alpha Chapter" indicating on the check "ICN Bookmobile." You will be sent a tax deductible receipt.
